



Arms on record in Ulster's Office.—Per pale indented argent and gules two lions rampant counter-changed each holding in the paws a dexter hand apaumée couped at the wrist proper on a chief vair three covered cups or.
Crest.—A dexter arm embowed vambraced the hand gauntleted grasping a covered cup or.
Motto.—Depressus tamen extollor.

James Delany of Newtown, Queen's County (son of William Delany of Newtown, by his wife, Elizabeth Carol of Clonbrook, Queen's County); born at Newtown in 1789, bapt. at the Catholic Chapel, Doonane, Queen's County; died at Middletown, Connecticut, U.S.A., in 1869, bur. there.

Carlow; born at Skehena 29 September 1828, bapt. at the Catholic Chapel, Ballylinan; marr. there 29 January 1862; died at Skehena on Saturday, 27 July, bur. at Arles 30 July 1901. Will dated 17 January 1900, proved in the Principal Registry, Dublin, 13 September 1901, by William Delany, M.D., and James Delany, Civil Engineer, sons.

William Delany of Bagnalstown, co. Carlow; born at Skehena 1 December 1862, bapt. at the Catholic Chapel, Ballylinan, Queen's County; educated at Clongowes Wood College; a Student of Carm College, Dublin, L.R.C.P.I. and L.M., L.R.C.S.I. and L.M. 1889; Surgeon Royal Irish Constabulary; J.P. for co. Carlow.

James Delany of Skehena House, Queen's County, and of Tullamore, King's County; born at Skehena 6 April 1864, bapt. at the Catholic Chapel, Ballylinan; educated at Clongowes Wood College, B.A. 1887, Bachelor of Engineering Royal University; County Surveyor for King's County; died at Harrogate, co. York, on Monday, 28 June, bur. at Arles on Friday, 2 July 1909. Will dated March 1908, proved at Dublin 12 August 1909, by William Delany, brother.

Annie, born at Skehena, Queen's County, 28 September 1865, bapt. at the Catholic Chapel, Ballylinan, Queen's County.

Josephine, born at Skehena 22 March, 1868, bapt. at the Catholic Chapel, Ballylinan.
